TRANSFIG THEN AND NOW - THANK YOU!

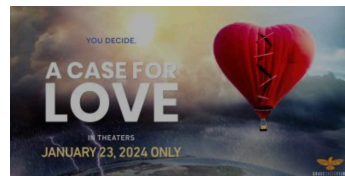
